# Greetings one and all,

Self-Advocacy Support group WILL meet on January 13th and February 10th.

They will continue on the 2nd Wednesday of each month thereafter. This is a support group for people 16 and older who receive supports and are interested in understanding their Rights and Responsibilities. This group meets from 5-6:30PM. Park in rear and use the Reception entrance – on far left when facing The Arc from the back parking lot (closest to Espresso Pizza).

The group typically orders take-out for dinner (optional).

#### The Arc would like to introduce its newest Family Support group:

#### Caregivers for youth/young adults

This group will meet January 14<sup>th</sup> and February 11<sup>th</sup> at the Riverside Apartments in Leominster MA. This group is for caregivers of individuals with disabilities under the age of 22.

Non-Disability specific group: WILL next meet Thursday, January 7<sup>th</sup> and February 4<sup>th</sup>. They will continue on the first Thursday of the month thereafter. Typically this group meets at the Lawrence Library in Pepperell from 10AM-12PM. For information contact Nancy Hanley @ 978-582-6203.

<u>Caregivers for people OVER 22:</u> WILL meet Thursday January 7<sup>th</sup> and February 4<sup>th</sup> from 10 to 11:30 AM. They will continue on the first Thursday of the month thereafter. Typically this is a support group for family members & caregivers of an adult with an intellectual or developmental disability. This group has lots of history and experience. Adult siblings are also encouraged to attend and share stories, triumphs, and roadblocks. This group is family driven; at times we have guest speakers come in and assist with concerns.

Monthly Dances is January 8<sup>th</sup> and February 12<sup>th</sup>, 569 Main St., Fitchburg. The building is accessible. Dances are from 7PM- 9:45PM and admission is \$7.00. Paid admission includes a drink and snack. Admission for families/staff/providers/respite workers etc. is complimentary but we do ask those with free admission to pay \$1.00 for a drink and/or snack at break time. Please do not arrive before 6:45PM and please be sure all pick-up rides arrive by 9:45PM. We would remind people that no one under the age of 16 attend or "visit" the dance (including family members). Anyone who needs assistance or who does not have sufficient "community unsupervised time", needs to be accompanied by family/staff/provider for the duration of the evening. Those who are 'independent' and unaccompanied should carry identification with emergency contact information. Thank you.

#### The Arc Recreation Scholarship Guidelines

Thanks to the generosity of the Monty Broc Rotary Club and the Scapparone and Ficarra families, The Arc of Opportunity is able to grant a limited number of scholarships for participation in many of the recreation programs we offer.

All applicants must submit the scholarship form including statement of need and details of request along with proof of Arc membership.

Individuals/families who hold current Arc membership may apply for a scholarship for **up to fifty percent** of the cost of desired activity or activities up to a **total maximum of \$500** per year.

Scholarships may be applied for up to 60 days in advance of an event and will be granted **based on availability of funds** for applicants meeting criteria; \*(exception - may apply 180 days in advance for the annual multi-day vacation trip). Applicants may apply for more than one activity in any year up to the maximum of \$500, based on the availability of funding; however, in an effort to help as many people as possible, priority will be given each year to new applicants. Individual/families applying for renewal scholarship will be considered in semi-annual increments during June and December of each year. This plan allows people to mix and match requests based on their needs but must remain under the \$500 annual scholarship cap.

#### Scholarship opportunities include:

**Weekend Recreation Club** - 1x month (value \$150), 2x month (\$250), 3x month (350) or 4xmonth (\$500) annually; pro-rated for partial year. Scholarship is for dues only; participant still pays activity fee. Individuals applying for a renewal scholarship could only do so for six months at a time, in June and December. Priority will be given to new applicants.

**Bowling** - may request up to fifty percent of season cost (season cost \$150; value of scholarship would be approximately \$75; prorated for partial season). Approved scholarship recipient will pay half price at each session.

**Family Fun Days** - (2 free admissions per family - value varies based on number of family members participating and activity - approx value \$50). Scholarship is for registration; participant pays any extra out of pocket costs.

**Holiday Dinner Dance** - (up to 4 half price tickets per individual/family. May be substituted for up to 2 free tickets on a case by case basis).

**Special Olympics** - (up to one free sport or two half price sports per year - approx value - \$60).

**Weekend trips** - (up to fifty percent of the trip cost - approx. value \$150).

**Vacation trips** - (up to fifty percent of trip cost or \$500 whichever is lower).

Dances - will be considered on a case by case basis.

<u>It is that time again for one of our most popular sports we offer - Basketball!</u> Below is what you need in order to participate! Looking forward to another season with all of our great basketball athletes!

- 1. A current Special Olympics Medical Application (SOMA) submitted to The Arc office
  - ✓ SOMAs can be found on: <a href="http://www.specialolympicsma.org/resources/forms-and-downloads/">http://www.specialolympicsma.org/resources/forms-and-downloads/</a> or call the Recreation Department to obtain one. Form should be completed by the athlete's primary care doctor and do not forget to have signed. A medical form is good for 3 years from the date signed.
- 2. Registration form below needs to be completed along with payment/payment plan or an approved scholarship. ALL REGISTRATIONS SHOULD BE IN NO LATER THAN MID-DECEMBER!
  - \*\*Important\*\* Each athlete who participates in the state game is charged for expenses like lodging, food, etc. When athletes are not charged by SOMA, The Arc absorbs these fees. With that said scholarships are available to those who are eligible members of The Arc (membership cost is \$20/yr per person.) We are also willing to work out a payment plan to those who request it as long as it is set up in advance. Fundraising through Special Olympics is possible too by contacting Special Olympics MA for more detail. No one will be turned away for inability to pay, but arrangements need to be set up. With this being said, all athletes MUST register with The Arc, pay their fees or set up a scholarship/payment plan in order to participate in any sport. Thank you ®

\*\*Note: Slots available for teams are based on a first come first served basis. With this being said, we unfortunately cannot guarantee anyone a spot to compete in state games. Also, please remember when signing up for a sport that you need to be fully committed to being a good team member. This means you should attend all practices with the exception of illness/vacations/emergencies, show respect to all teammates & coaches and making sure your schedule fits with scheduled competitions.

Inquire with your coach about practice times and any other details, as it varies from team to team!!
