

Empowering Individuals and Families.

- 98% of families expressed satisfaction with our services.
- 97% of individuals served reported high satisfaction.
- 97% of families would recommend The Arc of Opportunity.
- 85% of individuals across all programs have life plans using the Charting the LifeCourse tool.



Personalized Support

- 650 hours of one-on-one coaching provided for individuals with ASD.
- 2,280 hours of Allied Professional Support to enhance daily living skills in Day Habilitation.
- 6,808 hours of family respite delivered through after-hours and weekend recreation activities.
- 430 children across 121 families received gifts through the Holiday Giving Tree Initiative.



Community Inclusion and Engagement

- 61,776 hours of community-based day supports fostered social connections through CBDES.
- 13,728 volunteer hours contributed by day programs to local nonprofits.
- 180% increase in Day Habilitation community participation.
- Launched WOW program - 100% of program time spent in the community.




Independence, Advocacy, and Leadership


- 2,800 hours of employment support provided to individuals in community job placements.
