THE ABI PROGRAM PROVIDES RESIDENTIAL AND SUPPORT SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WITH AN ACQUIRED BRAIN INJURY. IN FY21, 25 INDIVIDUALS RECEIVED 6,609 DAYS OF RESIDENTIAL SERVICES IN 5 GROUP HOMES. THESE SERVICES INCLUDE ASSISTANCE WITH ACTIVITIES OF DAILY LIVING, MEDICAL AND DENTAL CARE, NUTRITION, AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES IN THE COMMUNITIES IN WHICH THEY LIVE. FOUR OF THESE INDIVIDUALS RECEIVED 731 HOURS OF ONE ON ONE PEER SUPPORT SERVICES TO ASSIST THEM IN ACTIVITIES OF THEIR CHOICE IN THE COMMUNITY. ALL PERSONS SERVED WERE PREVIOUSLY CONFINED TO NURSING HOMES. THE PROGRAM STRIVES TO ENHANCE THEIR RECOVERY BY INVOLVING THEM IN ACTIVITIES OF MAINTAINING A HOME. THE HOMES ARE DESIGNED TO BE FULLY ACCESSIBLE SO THAT RESIDENTS CAN PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES SUCH AS MEAL PREPARATION.
